Geoffroy Sartorius has been appointed Executive Vice President of Natixis Global Asset Management and Global Chief Financial Officer, effective July 1. He is a member of the Executive Committee of the Asset Management Division of Natixis. He reports to Pierre Servant, Global CEO of Natixis Global AM and member of the Executive Committee of Natixis.

Geoffroy Sartorius, 51, began his career in 1982 as a statistician at the French Ministry of Industry, then at INSEE (Budget and financial control). From 1987 to 1999, he held several positions in Capital Markets within the BNP Paribas group in Paris and in London. In 1999, he joined the Assets and Liabilities Management Division of the bank. In 2000, he took up the position of Head of Capital Markets of the Caisse Nationale des Caisses d'Epargne and, in 2002, became Head of Treasury and Government Securities at CDC IXIS Capital Markets. From 2004 to 2008, he was Chief Financial Officer at IXIS CIB and then Deputy Chief Financial Officer for Natixis.
